The workshop will take place on Monday 20 November. Below is an outline of what will be discussed.

Year 2 workshop

- 1. Introduction and assembly Recap
 - a. Recap on key messages received during the assembly
- 2. Recognising types of abuse
 - a. Identifying the abuses using the pictures and statements used in the assembly
- 3. Recognising feelings
 - a. Recap on Sam's story (delivered in assembly) with a focus on recognising feelings and what to do if you are feeling sad/frightened/upset
- 4. Readiness to tell
 - a. Discussion around safe adults and Childline contact details
- 5. Buddy Kit and ending
 - a. A special booklet that encourages children to think about their safe adults and safe places as well as a fun Buddy puppet to cut out and a book mark with Childline's details.
- 6. Stickers
 - a. All children will receive a special Speak Out. Stay Safe. Buddy sticker for their participation.
