Start times

Reception/KS1 gate will be open from 8.40am. (KS2 only – the gate will open from 8.30am.) Children **must not** be at school before these times.

Year 3, Y4, Y5 & Y6 children enter via the **main reception gate -** in Lockerbie Avenue

Reception, Y1 & Y2 children enter via the **KS1** playground gate – in Lockerbie Avenue

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#### **School Meals**

All School meals to be paid for via your ParentPay account, which if in credit, will process the payment and order your meals.

Menus for 25-26 will be on our website shortly, to order for our return to school.

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Reception & KS1 children receive FSM's daily. Yrs 3,4,5 & 6 - 22.55p per day. (212.75p wk)

Appointments

All appointments should be made out of school hours, to prevent disrupting your child's learning and the group/class.

If the appointment is urgent evidence must be provided in order for the absence to be marked 'medical' **This applies for ALL appointments** –

If there is no evidence provided, it will be recorded as an 'unauthorized absence'.
