Year 4 - School Visit to London's Natural History and Science Museums
Friday 5th June, 2026

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are excited to announce that we have arranged a trip for our Year 4 children to visit the Natural History Museum and the Science Museum in London to support the writing units that we intend to deliver during the summer term. The visit will also include the opportunity to see some iconic London sights such as the London Eye.

The trip will take place on Friday 5th June 2026, and the children will be accompanied on the visit by staff from the school.

On the day of the visit, children will need to **arrive in school between 7am – 7.15am** so that we are able to depart promptly at 7.30am.

Children will need to bring a packed lunch with additional snacks for both the morning and the evening.

We expect to **return to school between 6.30pm - 7:00pm** dependent upon traffic.

Children must not bring fizzy drinks or any foods containing nuts in their packed lunch.

If your child is in receipt of free school meals, a packed lunch will be provided by school. However, your child must still bring into school additional snacks for the morning and evening.

Children will need to come to school dressed in their school uniform. They should also bring an appropriate coat or jacket for the weather. Children may also choose to bring a hat or cap depending upon the weather.

Children will have the opportunity to purchase souvenirs when they stop near the London Eye, and so they are permitted to bring some spending money with them on the day up to a maximum of £10. This must be kept securely in an envelope or wallet which has your child's name on it. The school will not be held responsible for any money that is misplaced.

The cost of the visit is £25. Children who are in receipt of free school meals will be charged a subsidised price of £14.

If you would like your child to participate in the visit, please complete the attached permission slip and return it to school. Please also make the relevant payment via ParentPay.

Please note that unfortunately, if there is not sufficient interest, we will be unable to proceed with the visit. In the event of this happening, all payments will be refunded.
