



Geography

In geography, children will build a strong foundational understanding of spatial awareness and geographical inquiry by developing essential mapping skills. This topic is designed to move students from recognizing familiar environments to actively representing them on paper.

History

This term we will step back in time to explore the famous 1605 Gunpowder Plot, discovering who Guy Fawkes was, what happened, and why we still celebrate Bonfire Night today. The children will also learn about the life and impact of Sir David Attenborough, exploring his local connection to Leicestershire and how his love for nature helped him inspire the nation to protect our environment.

Art & Design

In Art, the children will get hands-on with 3D sculpture through our 'Paper Play' topic. They will experiment with rolling, folding, and scrunching paper to turn flat sheets into exciting 3D artwork.

Design Technology

In Design and Technology (DT), children will put their engineering skills to the test by designing and building custom chairs for their toy bears. Through hands-on experimentation, they will discover which materials offer the best strength and stability, and learn the most effective techniques for joining different components together.



This term's learning

Year 1/2

Computing



Children will learn how technology can help them. They will become more familiar with the different components of a computer by developing their keyboard and mouse skills, and also start to consider how to use technology responsibly.

PSHE/RSE

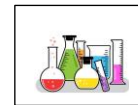


Children will be learning about community and the responsibilities that they have of being a valuable member of their varied communities by working together. They will also be talking about the differences people may have and how those unique qualities should be

P.E



In PE this term, children will learn how to incorporate hopping, jumping, running and balancing into games. This will help them to develop their spatial awareness of others and will show them a range of ways in which they can move around.



Science

In science, children will be exploring habitats. They will discover what plants and animals need to survive, master the seven life processes, and investigate how living things adapt to their environments. Afterwards, children will dive into materials science, examining the properties of different substances and determining the best materials to use for everyday objects.

Music



In Music, the children will explore Hip Hop and Reggae through energetic songs like 'Hey You!' and 'Banana Rap'. They will learn about rhythm and musical styles while having a go at breakdancing, graffiti art, and writing their own raps.

Religious Education

In R.E. the children will be learning about sacred books and why they are special to different religions. They will look at holy books from faiths like Christianity and Judaism, as well as learning about religions such as Hinduism and Sikhism. Through stories and discussions, pupils will discover how different people around the world learn about and share their beliefs.
