



Topic

History

Children will explore the contribution of the Ancient Egyptian Civilization through an in-depth study using images of artefacts.

Geography

Children will be observing and recording the location of rocks around the school grounds and discussing how they originated.

Art & Design

Children will explore and recognise processes involved in creating prehistoric art and apply their knowledge of colour mixing to make natural colours.

Design Technology

Children will design and construct a helmet for a specific user by choosing appropriate features. They will also analyse the strengths and weaknesses of helmets, evaluating how they work for their purpose.



What are We Learning in Year 3 during the Autumn Term?

Computing



Children will develop their understanding of digital devices, with a initial focus upon inputs, processes and outputs.

PSHE/RSE



Children will reflect on achievements to set positive personal goals for the year ahead. They will explore their rights and responsibilities within the school community and how choices affect others around them.

PE



In Basketball, children will learn how to control the ball when moving and with both hands. They will practise and perform various skills. In Tag Rugby, they will learn to hold and scoop a rugby ball and how to score and dodge from the opponent.

Science



Pupils will explore the fascinating world beneath their feet by grouping and testing different types of rocks and soils based on their physical properties and formation. They will also learn about how Fossils are produced over time.

French



Children will be learning essential greeting phrases, introducing themselves, and asking others how they are feeling.

Music



Children will be learning how to discuss the use of their instrument in class (A recorder) and learn songs from memory as well as the producers and creators of the song.

Religious Education



In RE, children will be exploring what Pilgrimage means to individuals and communities in Christianity, Hinduism and Judaism.
