



Topic

History

In History, the children will be learning all about the Second World War. They will explore the ideology of Adolf Hitler and the reasons that Neville Chamberlain declared war on Germany. They will also examine the effect of the Blitz and how British people adapted during the war. Including the use of evacuation, air raid shelters etc.

Art & Design

Pupils will get the chance to select fabrics, use templates and join materials to create a bag for a chosen person or purpose. This will give children another opportunity to practice their stitching technique as well as adding a personalised design at the end.

Design Technology

Children will be exploring how artists use space, scale and materials to create installation art that conveys ideas, transforms spaces and shapes the viewer's experience. This will culminate in the create of an art installation.

Geography

We are going to be examining global population patterns by investigating why some places are more densely populated than others. We will also be investigating the local area using different data collection methods and OS maps.



What are We Learning in Year 6 during the Autumn Term?

Computing



In computing this term, we are looking at Computer systems, networks, communication and collaboration. The children will learn all about the most effective ways to share work and collaborate with others. They will also learn about how data is transferred across the internet and websites are made.

PSHE/RSE



Being Me is the first topic the children will cover in PSHE. They will discuss their own personal goals and how to achieve them. They will also learn about bring a role model and what democracy means. Celebrating Differences will look at how every individual is different and how everyone should be respected.

PE

In PE this term the children will be working on passing, movement and teamwork in football. In rugby, pupils will learn the rules of how to move the ball forward up the field as well as the correct techniques to pass the ball.



Science



Science this term begins with how scientists such as Carl Linnaeus and Charles Darwin classified living things, including microorganisms. Children will learn how to ask questions and use Venn diagrams to find similarities and differences between living things. Following this, children will learn how animals and plants have adapted to their environment or habitat and why organisms may become extinct.

French



This term they learn how to speak about their school subjects in French. They will also learn vocabulary related to time and a school timetable. Finally, they will begin to express their opinions about which subjects they enjoy.

Music



In music this term the children will learn to listen and appraise music as well as practicing singing in unison to backing music. They will also create a simple melody with at least 5 notes and basic rhythm ending in a performance.

Religious Education

In RE, we will learn how different beliefs feel about the existence of God, concepts of 'evil', right and wrong and how we contribute to world peace. Students will link creation stories to create their own personal world view.
